I am aware that it is a sensitive subject, but I work for my client (you) and I can work around family members who do not wish to be filmed. I understand.

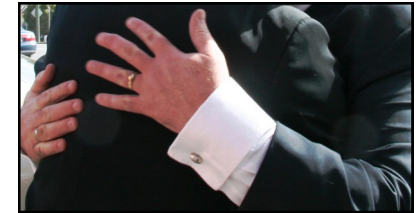
